

The School of Information Technology and Computer Science within the Faculty of Informatics is seeking appropriately qualified people to provide tutoring to students.

Tutors and demonstrators are employed on a sessional basis by the School to conduct tutorials, laboratory sessions, and marking. In addition they also participate in coordination meetings, in accordance with the tutorial and lab session allocations, under the direction of a subject coordinator.

The successful candidate will be required to meet the following essential criteria:

- Demonstrated successful completion of tertiary study in the relevant subject and/or have equivalent qualifications or have completed at least third year of study in relevant area; qualification should preferably be at honours or higher level.
- Demonstrated organisational, presentation and communication skills.

It is desirable that the successful candidate also meet the following criteria:

- Previous tertiary teaching experience
- Industry experience in relevant area

In addition to preparing and running tutorials, all tutors and demonstrators may be required to:

- Attend a training course for new staff that will be held during the week before the start of session;
- Attend a training course for returning staff that will be held during the week before the start of session.
- Participate in Student Feedback Questionnaire in weeks 10 - 13

Applicants who are students of the school or have previously done sessional work for the school must provide the name of a School staff member as a referee. Other applicants should provide the name and phone number of two referees. Applicants may be required to attend a selection interview. All applicants should be able to work until 16 June, 2006 (Session 1) and until 10 November, 2006 (Session 2).
